#### **Old Business**

- Review of email from Ragged Mountain attorney regarding an additional \$25k project contribution.
  - Response from GMI and Phelps Construction regarding project timeline.
     Selectmen discussed email and additional funds. Frances Bliss made a motion to hire Phelps
     Construction to complete the Ragged Mountain Road Improvement Project in the year 2025. A

contract will be drafted to ensure the contractor will follow the engineering design and guarantee the project cost. An additional memorandum to be sent to Ragged Mountain Resort advising them that they must correct the drainage issues in tandem with the road project. Motion seconded by James Farmer, all in favor.

- Review of tree removal quotes
  - Jessica Hatch made a motion to hire Dave Dyer to remove the trees around the roller shed for the cost of \$3000, James Farmer seconded the motion, all on favor. Frances will reach out to owner of abutting property to get permission to remove tree on their property.
- Called in response from owner of property in Danbury Woods with campers on it:
  - Owner states there were already campers on the property, and they thought they could simply replace them. They do have an outdoor privy on the property that was used previously. They plan to only leave the campers for the season while they work to clean up the property. Their plan is to build in the future, but they are not ready yet. Additionally, they do not have the ability to move the campers often and have to have them delivered to the property since they do not own a truck to move them. They are asking for further instructions or if they can leave them for the warmer months and use the outhouse already there.

The following is required for the campers to remain on the property:

- Completed building permit w/ fee must be submitted.
- Additional information provided about the existing outhouse.
- Campers can only remain on the property as seasonal residence and must be removed from property prior to winter season.

#### **New Business**

• Plan for pavilion at DES – do the selectmen need further detail or should they first apply for a permit? Selectmen spoke with the new principal of DES, Brittany Glavin, about the possibility of constructing an outdoor pavilion for the school. Advised that a building permit application would be needed and the fee waived due to it being for a school.
